## ➕ How badly do you need this?

Are you new to Ebay? Do you have a low feedback score and want to increase it rapidly? Do you want to make sure you do this ethically, safely, cost-effectively, and within the rules of Ebay? Then you've come to the right place!

## ➕ What is an Ebay feedback score anyway?




The Ebay feedback score is a rating system that allows Ebay buyers and sellers to rate each other at the conclusion of an Ebay transaction. Feedback may be rated as 'Positive', 'Neutral' or 'Negative'. Along with the rating, the person leaving feedback can insert a comment based on how smoothly the transaction went to buy from or sell to you. Here is an example of the type of comments people might make:

The feedback score is cumulative, so that if you had 3 transactions, positive, positive, then negative, your total score would be  $1+1-1=2$ . Similarly, if you had positive, negative, negative, your total score would be  $1-1-1=-1$ . This is a situation you want to avoid at all costs, a negative feedback score will make it very difficult for you to buy or sell anything on Ebay.

Along with your overall score, your feedback rating will include a 'positive feedback %'. This is a calculation of your overall positive feedback scores as a percentage of your total feedback scores for the life of your account. In addition to all of the above, your feedback rating will also list all your scores (positive, neutral and negative) for the last month, 6 months and 12 months. Here is an example:

Recent Ratings:

### Why would I want to increase my feedback score?

There are several reasons why you will want to increase your Ebay feedback score;

Firstly, many buyers will only buy from a seller with a relatively high feedback score. The reason for this is a higher feedback score gives you a certain amount of credibility. It signifies that you have been on Ebay for some time, and have had quite a number of successful transactions and happy people you have either bought from or sold goods or services to.

If you are selling an item, and another Ebay seller is selling the same item for the same price, but they have a greater feedback score than you, it is highly likely that the buyer will buy from the seller with the higher feedback score.

Additionally, many sellers will not sell to buyers with a feedback score of 0(zero) or less. The main reason for this, is that a feedback score of 0 or less more often than not signifies that the buyer is using a brand new account on Ebay, and they have not proven to be a reputable buyer. More often than not, you can remedy this and get the seller to allow you to bid on the auction. But why bother when you can boost your feedback rating before bidding?!

The second reason you will want to boost your feedback fast is so that you can participate in 'Dutch Auctions' if you are a seller, and also

‘Featured Plus’ listings. To access both these features as a seller you will need feedback ratings of 30 and 10 respectively. A Dutch Auction allows you to sell a number of items within the same listing for the same price, so if you have multiples of the same item to sell, getting to that magical feedback score of 30+ will be especially important for you.

### 🟢 **So gimme the lowdown, how do I boost my feedback score?!**

The method I am about to tell you about is ingeniously simple, yet amazingly ethical, cost-effective and within the rules of Ebay.

Firstly you will need to conduct an advanced search for items on Ebay. Click the ‘Advanced Search’ link in the top right-hand corner of the Ebay homepage.

In the ‘Items Priced’ section, set ‘Min’ as ‘0.01’ and Max as ‘0.01’. This will allow you to do a search for all items priced ‘0.01’ or one pence or cent (depending on which country you are in!).

In the ‘Show only’ section, tick the checkbox next to ‘Buy It Now items’, then click the ‘Search’ button at the bottom of the form.

Finally choose a category. I suggest you search under 'Information Products', as these will be most likely to have no postage costs (which is part of this strategy!).

If your results list returned includes items priced above '0.01', simply click the 'Price' link at the top of the results page to order the results from cheapest to most expensive. Now you are looking for 'Buy It Now' items priced '0.01' with 'Free postage'! Place bids on 100 of these auctions, and it will cost you a grand total of 1 dollar, one pound, one euro (Or whatever currency you are bidding in!) Once the transactions have been completed, leave positive feedback for the sellers, and ask politely that they do the same for you. You should have a feedback score of 100+ within a week or less. It's that simple! Get to it. 😊

### 🟢 **What now?**

Did you like this Ebook, and are you happy with the transaction that took place between yourself and the seller you bought it from? Then why not log into your Ebay account and leave them some positive feedback. Then contact the seller politely and ask them to leave you some positive feedback in return! It's all good karma!
